OBJECTIVE:

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide your organization with information on the government of Ontario's call for the 2018 Council of the Federation Literacy Award.

This year's award honours a nominee who has proven to be an innovator in developing and/or delivering literacy programming and demonstrated best practices to support seamless transitions across the adult education system. Nominees could be an individual, team, or organization.

We encourage you to nominate those that have demonstrated these qualities.

Submissions must be received by 5:00 P.M. on Friday May 25, 2018.

BACKGROUND:

- The Council of the Federation, which consists of Canada's 13 Premiers, works to promote inter-provincial / territorial cooperation and closer ties between members of the Council, as well as to show leadership on issues important to all Canadians. This includes encouraging programs, strategies and activities that promote literacy.
- Each year, each province and territory presents a Council of the Federation Literacy Award.
- The 2018 provincial and territorial award recipients will be announced by the Council of Federation the annual meeting on the Council (July 18-20, 2018).
- In addition to receiving the Council of the Federation Literacy Medallion and Certificate, the award recipient will also receive an education related prize, in a ceremony to be held in the fall or winter.
