Subject: Occupational Health and Safety Training Initiative

The Ministry of Labour, Training and Skills Development launched the Occupational Health and Safety Training Initiative in July 2020 to provide free online occupational health and safety training to jobseekers. To support the ministry in measuring the results of this initiative and for continuous improvement purposes, the Evaluation Unit, in collaboration with the Prevention Office, Employment Training Division, and Data Management Branch, has developed surveys to be administered to participants of the Occupational Health and Safety Training Initiative.

The purpose of the surveys is to collect information on participant outcomes, including perceptions of the training, knowledge development, user experience, and employment status.

The surveys will be administered between Winter 2020-21 until Winter 2021-22.

Next Steps

In the coming weeks, the ministry will work with the four private training providers offering the occupational health and safety courses to administer a survey following a participant's completion of the training. A follow-up survey will be conducted by the ministry at 3- and 12-months post-completion of the participant's training.
