OBJECTIVE:

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide your organization with information on how Ontario Self-Employment Benefit (OSEB) coordinator information will be listed on the EOPG.

BACKGROUND:

The Ministry of Training, Colleges, and Universities (MTCU) provides an online authoritative list of all Employment Ontario (EO) service providers through the “Find an Employment or Training Service” tool on the Ministry’s web site.

The public, Service Providers and MTCU staff use this online resource to identify locations for themselves and clients to access the services that they need. Since Employment Service (ES) sites are meant to be the first point of contact for a prospective client, those sites will be listed in the search results when a person requests OSEB from the drop down list called “Looking for Work”. Employment Service providers assess clients’ needs and refer clients to the appropriate programs and services in their community. To ensure that ES providers have the most current information for the OSEB coordinators in their communities, the Ministry will post a Provincial list of OSEB coordinators on the OSEB program page of the EOPG.
