
Canada Ontario Job Grant Update

Current Status

- As of August 31st 2016, more than 11,900 applications have been approved since program inception.
- This represents more than 70,600 training opportunities for 54,300 new or current employees in Ontario.
- More than 6,300 employers are benefiting from the Canada-Ontario Job Grant (COJG).
- In coming weeks, the ministry will be informing service providers of the business process for the 2017- 2018 fiscal year for all Employment Ontario programs, including COJG.

Current Status of Pilots

- As of August 2016, the Call for Proposals (CFP) for the COJG: UpSkill pilot has received seven applications:
 - Two were approved
 - Two were ineligible
 - Three are currently being evaluated
- Applicants have been notified of the results.
- As of May 2016, the COJG: Customized Training pilot continues to receive applications on an ongoing basis.
 - Eight Customized Training applications have been received, three of which are currently being evaluated.
