Subject: Youth Job Link Update - Case Closures and Report
Decommissioning

In follow-up to the [Youth Job Link \(YJL\) program being discontinued in 2019](#), the Ministry of Labour, Immigration, Training and Skills Development (the Ministry) will close the remaining open YJL cases in July 2022. The weekly and monthly Employment Ontario Information System (EOIS) Case Management System (CaMS) reports will be decommissioned in July and August 2022, respectively.

The Ministry had reviewed all 52 YJL open cases in EOIS-CaMS and concluded that, since there has been no activity in two years, these cases can be closed.

Service providers do not need to take any action and are to continue to serve youth through the relevant services available under Youth Job Connection, Youth Job Connection-Summer and Employment Service programs.
