The review decision is made considering not only the information originally available at the time the Notice of Contravention was issued, but also any new information not previously available that may have been supplied in support of the request for a review. On review, an administrative penalty may be upheld, rescinded or reduced. A review decision is final.

<p>PCCA, s. 11 Restrictions on advertising and soliciting</p> <p>On March 12, 2010, the website belonging to A Touch of Love Inc. (www.atouchoflove.ca) was reviewed by Ministry staff, who found it advertising a “Pet – Dog Grooming School” and a certification program in pet grooming. The school’s website advertises a full-time certificate program in pet grooming which teaches students to become professional stylists and consists of 6 months of instruction, 5 days per week at 40 hours per week. Tuition fees cost \$8,000. Based on this information, the full-time certificate program in pet grooming would consist of approximately 960 hours and would therefore fit the definition of vocational programs according to the PCCA, 2005 and requires the approval of the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges.</p>	<p>\$1,000 per day</p>	<p>The penalty was reduced to \$1.</p> <p>The balance of evidence available indicates that A Touch of Love Inc. was advertising an unapproved vocational program and an unregistered private career college. A Touch of Love Inc. came into compliance by discontinuing all advertising of an unapproved vocational program and an unregistered private career college.</p>
