

Particulars of Notice of Contravention and Review Decision

S. 49(1) *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* (“Act”)

September 15, 2011

These particulars are posted following the issuance of an administrative penalty for which a review was requested. Penalties may be reviewed upon request within 15 days of receipt of a Notice of Contravention. The review decision is made considering not only the information originally available at the time the Notice of Contravention was issued, but also any new information not previously available that may have been supplied in support of the request for a review. On review, an administrative penalty may be upheld, rescinded or reduced. A review decision is final.

<p>Act, s. 7 – Prohibition against operating a private career college</p> <p>This business advertised itself as a registered career college in Ontario at http://www.buynccell.ca/products/iPhone-N-Blackberry-Training-%252d-Course-Registration-%28July-26th-%2C-2011%29.html. The business also made available online “Terms and Conditions” which mimicked some of the required student protections made available to students under the <i>Private Career Colleges Act, 2005</i>. As a result of this evidence, the Superintendent came to the reasonable belief that a student or prospective student may believe that this business was a registered private career college.</p> <p>Therefore, the Designate came to the reasonable belief that the School was holding itself out as the operator of a private career college without being registered, in contravention of section 7(2) of the Act.</p>	<p>Daily penalty of \$,1000</p>	<p>Penalty of \$1,000 per day is upheld for August 23, 2011.</p> <p>The balance of evidence available indicates that American College of Business and Technology Inc. was holding itself out as a registered private career college. American College of Business and Technology Inc. came into compliance on August 23, 2011.</p>
