**Re: Paxtan Career Education Inc. o/a Bond College of Business & Technology (“Bond”)**

**Notice of Immediate Suspension under section 20 of the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* (“Act”)**

---

I have been advised that the corporation Paxtan Career Education Inc. operating as Bond College of Business & Technology is not a registered corporation with the Province of Ontario. I am, therefore, providing notice of the immediate suspension of its Private Career College registration.

### **Facts in Support of Decision to Suspend**

In my opinion, the following facts support my decision to suspend the registration of Bond.

A corporate search has revealed that Paxtan Career Education Inc. was cancelled as a corporate entity on August 4, 2008 due to its failure to comply with the Corporations Tax Act. Bond does not, therefore, have the legal capacity to enter into contracts with new students or to comply with the provisions of the Private Career Colleges Act, 2005.

Despite Ministry staff’s communication with Bond on April 30 and May 1, 2009, no response or corrective action plan has been received.

### ***Immediate Suspension***

Section 20 of the Act provides that the Superintendent may suspend a registration immediately by giving the registrant a notice of immediate suspension if the Superintendent is of the opinion that it is necessary to do so. For the immediate protection of the interests of prospective students, I am suspending Bond's registration, **effective immediately**.

The Superintendent will consider lifting the immediate suspension when Bond's corporate registration issues are resolved.

Bond has the right to appeal the suspension and the proposal to refuse to renew its registration. ***Information on the appeal*** process is set out in Schedule "A", attached to this letter.

As a result of my decision,

1. Effective immediately, Bond may no longer continue to enrol students in courses registered under the Act.
2. Bond may continue to train students enrolled in registered programs, however it may not collect any money from students.
3. Bond will deliver to me **by registered mail or courier and by no later than Friday, May 15, 2009** a written confirmation signed by an authorized officer of Bond:
  - a) subject to paragraph 2, that Bond is no longer in operation or, if it is in operation, that it is not providing training which requires registration under the Act;
  - b) the names and addresses of all of Bond's students currently attending Bond's facility at 720 Midland Avenue, Toronto, Ontario;
  - c) that Bond does not hold, directly or indirectly, any monies owing to current, former or prospective students with contracts with the school.
4. Bond will deliver to me along with the written confirmation under clause 2, copies of current student contracts, attendance records and proofs of payment on account of tuition and related supplies related to the students.
5. Bond is prohibited from advertising on its web site and in all other media that it is offering programs that are approved under the Act or that it is a registered private career college under the Act during the suspension.
6. All references to Bond will be removed from the Service Ontario website, as well as from any other relevant information sources, due to the change in its status.

**Failure to Comply with the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005***

If you continue to operate despite this Suspension Order, you will be operating in violation of section 20 of the *Act* and may be subject to penalties pursuant to s. 48 of the *Act*. This may preclude subsequent registration under the *Act* on the grounds that you are carrying on activities in contravention of the *Act*.

Note that a corporation that is found guilty of an offence under section 48 of the *Act* is subject to a fine of up to \$100,000, and any officer or director of a corporation who concurs in the commission of such an offence is also guilty of an offence, and on conviction subject to a fine of up to \$25,000 or imprisonment for a term of up to one year, or both.

Failure to comply with the terms of this Order may result in publication of the Order on the Ministry's public website.

The legislation applicable to this Order is the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* and Ontario Regulation 415/06 made thereunder. The legislation and regulation is available at [www.e-laws.gov.on.ca](http://www.e-laws.gov.on.ca).

## SCHEDULE "A"

### ENTITLEMENT TO HEARING BY LICENCE APPEAL TRIBUNAL:

If Paxtan Career Education Inc. o/a Bond College of Business & Technology disagrees with the Superintendent's decision, it is entitled to a hearing by the Licence Appeal Tribunal ("Tribunal") if it mails or delivers to both the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges and the Tribunal a notice in writing, requesting such a hearing.

Such notice must be delivered, **by registered mail or courier**, to the Superintendent and to the Tribunal by **Tuesday, May 26, 2009**.

If Bond does not require a hearing by the Tribunal as set out above, the decision to suspend the registration will continue until the registration is revoked or until Bond's registration lapses.

**Note: In the case of an immediate suspension issued under section 20 of the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005*, a request for a hearing by Bond does not stay the suspension: the suspension continues, unless otherwise directed by the Tribunal.**
