

Particulars of a Restraining Order

S. 49 (2) Private Career Colleges Act, 2005 ("Act")

These particulars are posted following the issuance of a Restraining Order against an unregistered private career college by the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges pursuant to s. 46 (2) of the Act.

Contraventions

The Superintendent has ordered Durham Flight Centre Inc. to stop:

- Operating a private career college contrary to s. 7 (1) of the Act;
 - Offering or providing an unapproved vocational program contrary to s. 8 (1) of the Act;
- and
- Charging or collecting a fee in relation to an unapproved vocational program contrary to s. 9 (1) of the Act.

Required Actions

By May 2, 2013, Durham Flight Centre Inc. is required by the Superintendent to provide written confirmation signed by a person with authority to bind the corporation, together with all available supporting evidence, confirming that they:

- A. Have stopped operating a private career college;

- B. Have stopped offering or providing an unapproved vocational program, namely the commercial pilot licensing (“CPL”) program; and
- C. Have stopped charging or collecting a fee in relation to an unapproved vocational program, namely the CPL program.

Note: Nothing in this Order prevents Durham Flight Centre Inc. from providing non-vocational flight training programs to the public or vocational programs exempt under the Act, such as programs funded exclusively by third parties.
