

Particulars of Notice of Contravention and Review Decision

S. 49(1) *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005*

These particulars are posted following the issuance of an administrative penalty for which a review was requested. Penalties may be reviewed upon request within 15 days of receipt of a Notice of Contravention. The review decision is made considering not only the information originally available at the time the Notice of Contravention was issued, but also any new information not previously available that may have been supplied in support of the request for a review. On review, an administrative penalty may be upheld, rescinded or reduced. A review decision is final.

The Designate asked Ms. Curry for additional details about the Introduction to Travel and Tourism program listed on the school’s website. Ms. Curry provided the following information about the program:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The program trains you to become a Travel Agent;... • The program costs \$1,200 Canadian dollars;... • Part of the “curriculum” involves attending a virtual classroom two nights per week for two hours each night (excluding the above program hours, 4 hours per week virtual classroom x 32 weeks = 128 hours duration);... 	<p>\$1,000 per day</p>	<p>Penalty was reduced to \$250 per day for the period of December 20, 2010 – December 21, 2010.</p> <p>The balance of evidence available indicates that Donna Curry advertised an unregistered private career college and unapproved vocational programs. Donna Curry discontinued all advertising and came into compliance on December 21, 2010.</p>
