#### **NOTICE OF CONTRAVENTION**

This letter is to inform you as the Director of 1382221 Ontario Ltd. (Great Lakes) that on April 7, 2010, it was determined that Great Lakes contravened the following section of the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* and/or of regulations made under the Act:

#### **Act, s. 15(3) – Registrant to comply with conditions (\$750)**

As per section 51 of *Ontario Regulation 415/06* of the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* CompuCampus is required to pay penalties totaling \$750 within **30 days** of the date of this notice. At this time you are required to pay this total.

**Schedule A**  
**DETAILED REASONS FOR DECISION**

**Act, s. 15(3) – Registrant to comply with conditions (\$750)**

On April 7, 2010 a designate of the Superintendent visited 6460 Hawthorne Dr., Windsor, Ontario to conduct a change in campus location inspection of Great Lakes (Registration No. 106459). This inspection was conducted as the final step in the process before the Superintendent considers approval for the proposed change in campus location from 6555 Malden Rd. Lasalle, Ontario.

The Superintendent's designate found the proposed campus already open and operating without the necessary approval; without a fire inspection report conducted by the local fire authorities; without final approval from the Technical Standards and Safety Authority (TSSA) which is the non-regulatory professional body administering the certification of the occupations for which Great lakes was offering training (Gas Technician 2 and 3); without employed instructors completing the required Instructor Qualification Data Forms and offering vocational programs without being approved at this location contrary to s. 15(3) of the Private Career Colleges Act, 2005.

- Gas tech training without proper approvals despite
- TSSA did not inspect and approve until May 6, 2010
- Ms. Pouget stated to the Inspector that the decision to open and enroll students prior to approval was strictly a 'business decision'
