Contraventions

The Superintendent has ordered the Hancock Corporation operating as Tokyo Sushi Academy to stop:

- Advertising an unregistered private career college and unapproved vocational programs contrary to s.11(1) and (2) of the Act;
- Delivering unapproved vocational programs for a fee at an unregistered campus contrary to s.8(1) of the Act;
- Charging fees for unapproved vocational programs that require approval contrary to s.9 of the Act; and
- Operating a private career college without being registered, contrary to s.7 of the Act.

Required Actions

By May 4, 2012, The Hancock Corporation operating as Tokyo Sushi Academy is required by the Superintendent to provide written confirmation signed by a person with authority to bind the corporation, together with all available supporting evidence, confirming that they:

- A. Have stopped advertising an unregistered private career college and unapproved vocational programs;
- B. Have stopped delivering unapproved vocational programs for a fee at an unregistered campus;
- C. Have stopped charging fees for unapproved vocational programs that require approval;
and
- D. Have stopped operating a private career college without being registered.
