

**Particulars of Notice of Contravention and Review Decision**

*S. 49(1) Private Career Colleges Act, 2005*

These particulars are posted following the issuance of an administrative penalty for which a review was requested. Penalties may be reviewed upon request within 15 days of receipt of a Notice of Contravention. The review decision is made considering not only the information originally available at the time the Notice of Contravention was issued, but also any new information not previously available that may have been supplied in support of the request for a review. On review, an administrative penalty may be upheld, rescinded or reduced. A review decision is final.

<p>PCCA, s. 11 Restrictions on advertising and soliciting</p> <p>Ministry staff viewed the website <a href="http://www.hawkesburyuniversity.com">www.hawkesburyuniversity.com</a> belonging to Hawkesbury Mosque operating as Hawkesbury School of Higher Studies (HSHS) known as Hawkesbury University ("Hawkesbury University") on April 9, 2010. The webpage entitled "Courses and Programs" provides a list of certificate and diploma courses offered, including Advanced Postgraduate Diplomas in Business Administration. Unapproved individual and certificate courses are listed as costing \$1200 for 3 months and unapproved certificate and diploma courses are listed as costing \$4000 for 12 months of study. Business Administration programs correspond</p>	<p>\$1,000 per day</p>	<p>Penalty of \$1,000 per day is upheld for the period of April 27, 2010 – April 28, 2010.</p> <p>The balance of evidence available indicates the PCC was advertising unapproved vocational programs. The PCC has come into compliance on April 28, 2010 as it no longer advertises unapproved vocational programs.</p>

<p>to National Occupational Classification (NOC) code 1122 Professional Occupations in Business Services to Management. Since Hawkesbury University is not registered as a private career college under the PCCA, 2005, and the certification and diploma courses are not approved, advertising them is prohibited.</p>
