NOTICE OF CONTRAVENTION

This letter is to inform you as the President of North American School of Information Technology Inc. (NASIT) that on July 29, 2010, it was determined that NASIT contravened the following section of the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* and/or of regulations made under the Act:

Act, s. 15(3) – Registrant to comply with conditions (\$750)

As per section 51 of *Ontario Regulation 415/06* of the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* NASIT is required to pay penalties totaling \$750 within **30 days** of the date of this notice. DETAILED REASONS FOR DECISION

Act, s. 15(3) – Registrant to comply with conditions (\$750)

On July 29, 2010, it came to the attention of a designate of the Superintendent that NASIT (Registration No. 101256) had relocated from 3609 Sheppard Avenue East, Toronto, ON, M1T3K8 to 206-2500 Lawrence Ave. East, Toronto, ON, M1P 2R without notifying the Superintendent, submitting the required documentation or obtaining the necessary approvals. The designate of the Superintendent placed a phone call to the campus administrator, Linda Ng who confirmed that the PCC has been offering vocational programs (PSW and Information Technology) since February 14, 2010 without them being approved at this location contrary to s. 15(3) of the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005*.
