These particulars are posted following the issuance of an administrative penalty for which a review was requested. Penalties may be reviewed upon request within 15 days of receipt of a Notice of Contravention. The review decision is made considering not only the information originally available at the time the Notice of Contravention was issued, but also any new information not previously available that may have been supplied in support of the request for a review. On review, an administrative penalty may be upheld, rescinded or reduced. A review decision is final.

<p>Act. s. 11 – Restrictions on advertising and soliciting</p> <p>On February 17, 2010, the website belonging to Rosemont Healing Arts http://rosemonthealingarts.com/, was reviewed by Ministry staff who found it advertising a Zen Shiatsu Diploma program. The website stated that the course takes 500 hours, but did not list the cost.</p> <p>On February 17, 2010, Ministry staff phoned Rosemont and spoke with Joan, who advised that the course costs \$5,000.00 plus taxes and other additional expenses. She advised that she is waiting for 6 students to enrol in the course before beginning classes.</p>	<p>\$1,000 per day</p>	<p>Penalty was reduced to \$1 per day. The penalty is upheld for March 2, 2010.</p> <p>The balance of evidence available indicates that Joan Foley was advertising an unregistered private career college. The private career college came in to compliance by removing all advertising of the Shiatsu program from its website.</p>
