On review, an administrative penalty may be upheld, rescinded or reduced. A review decision is final.

<p>Act. s. 11 – Restrictions on advertising and soliciting</p> <p>On February 11, 2010, the website, <a href="http://www.taosangha-na.com/tao-shiatsu/training">http://www.taosangha-na.com/tao-shiatsu/training</a>, was reviewed by Ministry staff who found it advertising a Tao Shiatsu Level 1 Practitioner Course for Tao Shiatsu Canada Corp. The website did not list the cost or duration of the program.</p> <p>On February 17, 2010, Ministry staff phoned Tao Shiatsu Canada Corp. and spoke with Alex, who advised that the course costs around \$5,000.00, and consists of approximately 500 instructional hours delivered over the course of three years.</p>	<p>\$1,000 per day</p>	<p>Penalty of \$1,000 is upheld for March 2, 2010.</p> <p>The balance of evidence available indicates that the private career college (PCC) was advertising an unapproved vocational program. The PCC has come into compliance as it no longer advertises the Shiatsu program.</p>
