Notice of Contravention #002

NOTICE OF CONTRAVENTION

This letter is to inform the Toronto School of Music Inc., operating as Toronto School of Music Canada that on 01/12/2009, it was determined that Toronto School of Music Inc., operating as Toronto School of Music Canada contravened the following section of the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* and/or regulations made under the Act:

- Failure to comply with an order of the Superintendent made under s. 46 of the Act
- Act, s. 11 — Restrictions on advertising and soliciting

As per section 51 of *Ontario Regulation 415/06* made under the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005*, Toronto School of Music Inc., operating as Toronto School of Music Canada is subject to a penalty in the total amount of \$2,000 per day. It is important to note that the penalty is levied daily. The total penalty amount is calculated by multiplying the penalty amount indicated above by the number of successive days that the contravention continues.

For example: following 5 successive days that the contravention continues the penalty amount due will be \$10,000.

following 15 successive days that the contravention continues the penalty amount due will be \$30,000.

At this time you are required to provide the ministry with written confirmation of compliance with the Act.

Please supply the ministry with the following documents confirming that you have come into compliance with the Act:

- Confirmation that Toronto School of Music Inc., operating as Toronto School of Music Canada has stopped advertising unapproved vocational programs (on its website).
- A list including the names and addresses of all current students enrolled in unapproved vocational programs.
- Verification that Toronto School of Music Inc., operating as Toronto School of Music Canada has issued refunds to students who were enrolled in unapproved vocational

programs. Ministry staff seized evidence confirming the institution has enrolled students in its vocational programs.

Once you have confirmed compliance with the Act, the penalties will cease to accumulate and the ministry will notify you of the total penalty outstanding. Payment of the full amount is due within **30 days** of the date of your notification.

If payment is not received within **30 days** after the date the notice of contravention was received, the amount will be subject to interest at the current post-judgment interest rate beginning on the 31st day following the date of notice. The current rate can be found at the following address:

Review

If you believe that the decision made above is inaccurate you may request a review of this decision by submitting a Request for a Review of a Notice of Contravention form to the Minister of Training, Colleges and Universities within **15 days** of receipt of the Notice of Contravention.
